

PREFACE

This *Digest of Selected Social and Demographic Indicators for CDCC Member Countries, 1960–1995* represents an update of an earlier document – *Regional Digest of Selected Demographic and Social Indicators* – published in 1991.

A principal motivating factor for this second volume has been the need to understand the complex social and economic implications of population dynamics. The current issue, therefore, brings together a wide range of social, economic and demographic data with a view to promoting understanding of the nature of these linkages and encouraging the integration of population in development planning. In this regard, population-related socio-economic information, including employment, household aspects, education and health, is combined with data on the demographic characteristics and behaviour of the population subgroups – children, youth, working age group and the elderly.

The primary sources of material are the 1960–1990/91 censuses and the national statistical reports.

Responsibility for this publication rests with the Demography Unit of the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean (ECLAC), Subregional Headquarters for the Caribbean, Port of Spain. The revision was facilitated to a great extent, however, by the close collaboration between ECLAC's Demography Unit and the National Population Units, Planning Ministries, Statistical Offices and Family Planning Associations in the Caribbean.

We therefore trust that this second issue will attract the interest of a wide cross-section of international organizations, research and training institutions and other bodies dealing with questions related to population and development in the Caribbean. It is our hope that governments will find the information provided of some assistance in their population and development programme formulation, implementation and planning exercises.

Finally, the assistance of the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) in providing funding for this publication, through the UNFPA/ECLAC subregional project "Integrating Population in Development Planning for the Caribbean", is gratefully acknowledged.

1980/81 and 1990/91











1980–1992**



Health personnel, Belize






1960–1990/91**





1960–1990/91**







1960–1990/91



1960–1990/91**



Index of aging, 1960–1991



GLOSSARY

CRUDE BIRTH RATE (CBR)	The number of live births in a year per 1,000 mid-year population.
GENERAL FERTILITY RATE (GFR)	The number of live births in a given year per 1,000 women of childbearing age.
AGE-SPECIFIC FERTILITY RATE (ASFR)	The number of live births in a given year to women of a given age group per 1,000 women in that age group.
TOTAL FERTILITY RATE (TFR)	The number of children a woman would have during her lifetime if she were to experience the fertility rates of the period at each age.
CHILD-WOMAN RATIO	The ratio of children under 5 years old to women of childbearing age.
CRUDE DEATH RATE (CDR)	The number of deaths in a year per 1,000 mid-year population.
AGE-SPECIFIC DEATH RATE (ASDR)	The number of deaths of persons of a given age during a year per 1,000 mid-year population at that age.
CAUSE-SPECIFIC DEATH RATIO	The per cent of all deaths due to a particular cause or group of causes.
INFANT MORTALITY RATE (IMR)	The number of deaths to infants under 1 year of age in a given year per 1,000 live births in that year.
NEONATAL MORTALITY RATE	The number of deaths to live-born infants during the first month of life in a given year per 1,000 live births in that year.
EARLY NEONATAL MORTALITY RATE	The number of deaths to live-born infants during the first week of life in a given year per 1,000 live births in that year.
LATE NEONATAL MORTALITY RATE	The number of deaths to live-born infants between 7 days and 27 days of age in a given year per 1,000 live births in that year.
POST NEONATAL MORTALITY RATE	The number of deaths to live-born infants between 1 month and 11 months of age in a given year per 1,000 live births in that year.
UNDER 5 MORTALITY RATE	The number of deaths of children under 5 years of age in a given year per 1,000 live births in that year.
LIFE EXPECTANCY AT BIRTH	The average number of years of life a new born infant may be expected to live under the schedule of age-specific mortality currently in effect.
YOUTH DEPENDENCY RATIO	The ratio of persons aged 0–14 to the population of working age, 16–64 years.
OLD AGE DEPENDENCY RATIO	The ratio of persons 65 years of age and over to the population of working age, 15–64 years.

GLOSSARY

TOTAL DEPENDENCY RATIO	The ratio of persons aged 0–14 plus those aged 65 and over to the population of working age, 15–64 years.
AGING OF THE POPULATION	A gradual process in which the proportions of adults and elderly increase in a population while the proportions of children and young persons decrease.
CHILDBEARING YEARS	The reproductive age span of women, assumed to be 15–49 years.
NATURAL INCREASE	The surplus (or deficit) of births over deaths in a population in a given time period.
DEMOGRAPHIC TRANSITION	The historical shift of birth and death rates from high to low levels in a population.
POPULATION MOMENTUM	The tendency for population growth to continue beyond the time that replacement level fertility had been achieved because of a relatively high concentration of women in the childbearing years.
POPULATION POLICY	Explicit or implicit measures instituted by a government to influence the population size, growth, distribution or composition.
POPULATION DENSITY	Number of people per unit of land area.
SEX RATIO	The number of males per 100 females
AVERAGE ANNUAL RATE OF GROWTH (%)	The rate at which a population grows/declines over a specified period, assuming a constant rate of growth or decline over the period.
INDEX OF AGING	The ratio of 0–14 population to the 65 years and over population.

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
