

LA REUNION SOBRE PROBLEMAS DE VIVIENDA, INDUSTRIAS DE EDIFICACION Y DE
MATERIALES DE CONSTRUCCION EN CENTROAMERICA Y PANAMA

CONSIDERANDO:

1. Que la investigación juega un importante papel en la elevación del nivel tecnológico de nuestras industrias de construcción, no solamente reduciendo costos de producción, sino también mejorando la calidad de los productos;
2. Que las características geográficas de los países del Istmo determinan características que son comunes lo cual hace pensar en la posibilidad de realizar programas de investigación en escala regional;

RESUELVE:

Recomendar a los gobiernos de los países del Istmo:

1. El establecimiento de organismos que realicen investigaciones en el campo de la construcción.
2. Para la realización de estas investigaciones solicitar al ICAITI "organismo regional encargado de llevar a cabo investigaciones tecnológicas industriales para Centroamérica" la coordinación de las mismas con el objeto de complementar las investigaciones que individualmente realicen evitando así la duplicidad de esfuerzos y permitiendo el intercambio de información.
