Programme of activities

Taesday 14 August

9.30 a.m. Opening session

10.30 a.m. First working meeting. Theme: <u>Basic principles of modular</u> coordination.

Fist part: Prevailing criteria to achieve efficiency and flexibility in the production of elements, in the operations and in the constructions.

3.00 p.m. Second working meeting. Theme: Basic principles of modular coordination (continuation)

Second part: Basic terminology. Selection of a basic module. Advantages and promotion. Determination of the design module, of tolerances and of working measurements. Technical principles.

Wednesday 15 August

9.00 a.m. Third working meeting. Theme: Modular coordination in relation to the industrial process for the production of construction materials and of housing equipment.

First part: Erick walls (Meeting at the "Insalco" brick factory). Production process. Types and sizes. Utilization. Diversity of joints. Tolerances. Alterations in the industrial process necessary for the production of modular bricks. Time required and possible financial implications.

3.00 p.m. Fourth working meeting. Theme: Modular coordination in relation to the industrial process for the production of construction materials and of housing equipment (cont.)

Brick walls. Utilization of modular coordination in the erection of brick walls. Structural possibilities, design and architecture. Elue-prints. Graphic representation.

Interchangeability of elements. Placement in buildings, joints and tolerances. Alterations required in the process for producing moduled doors and windows. Time required and possible financial implications.

 Doors and windows. Application of modular coordination to doors, windows and partitions. Relation to structures and design. Blueprints and construction details.

Time required and possible financial implications.
